INSTRUCTIONS FOR FILING APPEAL FROM OPERATORS' LICENSE SUSPENSION/MOTOR VEHICLE REGISTRATION SUSPENSION

1. Fill in caption on proposed Order (Your Name above Petitioner/Appellant). DO not fill anything else out on that page. The Court Administrator will fill in date and time of hearing.
2. Fill in blanks with information as they apply to your case. Indicate whether it is your license that is being suspended or your vehicle registration. The service of the appeal must go to the correct mailing address in Harrisburg so it is important that license/registration information is noted. Check the correct blank for service to the correct department. Attached a **copy** of any notice or letter you received from PennDOT.
3. In Area # 4, check the blank if you are desiring to keep your license pending the resolution of the appeal.
4. In Area # 5, indicate, as concisely as possible, the reasons/nature of your appeal. Why should the Court overrule the Department's decision.
5. Sign and date the Petition.
6. Sign and date the attached Verification.
7. File the petition (and pay filing fee) with the Wayne County Prothonotary's Office, 925 Court Street, Honesdale, Pa. 18431. Once a case number is assigned to the case, request the petition be forwarded to the Court Administrator for the assignment of a hearing date/time.
8. Once a hearing date has been assigned. Service of the Petition and scheduling Order must be made upon the appropriate department and proof of this service must be filed with the Prothonotary.
